Hi dear Kaj Goetszhe and the community of Lemvig, Denmark.

My name is Rev. Ize Haman. I'm in charge for Francophone Yelwa Parish as a Pastor of Garoua, Cameroon.

It is grateful for me to connect with you and your community regarding the relationship our two parishes have maintained for some years.

First, we apologize for the delay and the lack of contact we've had regarding the sharing of activities between our two parishes. However, we are grateful for your financial support every year to our community, which is still a work in progress building. Last year, for example, you received from your community € 2,000, which we received through our office sanded by Mission Afrika.

Evangelistic activities are progressing positively here in Garoua, Cameroon, and we continue to lead the parish, which has a growing of members.

Our parish here have actually approximately 800 members who attend services every Sunday. Two years ago, we established a small branch parish near Garoua, which has about 47 members. We continue to support and to guide it as it grows.

Our activities include Bible studies held every Wednesday evening, women's and youth meetings every Friday and Saturday. On Sunday morning small children have their school in the same time with church's service.

Because the year draws to a close, our parish is already preparing for the celebration of recognition to God. Christians have to bring what you have prepare for God during the year. Meanwhile, we are wrapping up our harvest celebration, and after that, we will begin fundraising for the ongoing construction of our parish.

Our parish regularly broadcasts its Sunday services on a Facebook forum called AMEN INFOS. This is to allowing members who are unable to attend services physically to follow the service on live.

The entire community is deeply grateful and thanks you very much for your support and for your prayers. We believe that our two communities can share information and hope to be in contact definitively with you through our partner Mission Afriaka and our administration in Garoua to ensure the communication and good collaboration.
